Man arrested after allegations of robbing and shooting another male

A man is behind bars this morning after allegations that he robbed and shot another male. Back on January 30, 2021, Shreveport Police responded to the 4800 block of Monkhouse Drive relative to a shooting. Officers located adult male Brian Atkins suffering from a gunshot injury to the chest. The victim was transported with life-threatening injuries.

Evidence led Violent Crimes investigators to determine that Atkins was shot after he accepted a ride from Nathan Carl Lee (6/15/1986). While Atkins was in the car with Lee, Lee robbed Atkins and shot him in the chest. Atkins was put out of the car in the 4800 block of Monkhouse Drive. Detectives procured an arrest warrant for Lee back in early February 2021 charging him with one count of Attempted Second Degree Murder and Armed Robbery. On Wednesday, March 3, 2021, Investigators received a tip that Lee was in the 5000 block of Interstate Drive. Detectives along with the assistance of outside law enforcement agencies were able to take Nathan Lee into custody. He was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
