Man arrested on multiple charges following incident in Shreve City

A Shreveport man has been arrested and charged with numerous charges this morning after an incident in Shreve City. On April 8, 2021, just after 8:00 a.m., Shreveport Police received information that a man possibly wanted in connection with a stolen vehicle was at the Walmart Super Center located at 1100 Shreveport Barksdale Highway. When officers arrived on the scene and attempted to contact the adult male in the parking lot, he immediately ran inside the store, leading officers on a foot pursuit. As the male was running out and exiting the store, he attempted to throw away multiple illegal firearms which were in his possession. The male was quickly apprehended a short distance across the street from Walmart in the 2900 block of Knight Street. While attempting to apprehend the male on Knight Street, a marked Shreveport Police Department vehicle sustained minor damage after making contact with a large bush. The officer was not injured. The suspect, later identified as Robert Allen (31) was charged with two counts of Illegal Carrying of Weapons, one count of Illegal Possession of a Stolen Firearm, two counts of Resisting an Officer, and one count of Hit and Run. Allen was booked into the Shreveport City Jail
