Police seek to Identify man accused of north Shreveport business robbery

Shreveport Police are asking the public's help to identify a man believed responsible for the robbery of a dollar store in early August.

On August 1, 2021, just before 9:00 p.m., Shreveport Police Patrol officers responded to the Family Dollar Department Store in the 2600 block of Dr. Martin Luther King Drive on reports of an armed robbery.

Arriving officers learned that a male subject allegedly entered the business and was able to hide within the store until the store closed. Shortly after the closing the man, who was armed with a handgun, approached the clerk and demanded money. The subject was described as a black male wearing a black t-shirt, red pants, and a hat with a white cloth covering it.

Investigators assigned to the case obtained video surveillance from the scene and are releasing still images taken from the video to the public asking in hopes of getting the individual identified.
