Adult and juvenile charged in shooting incident

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Investigators have arrested an adult male and a juvenile following a shooting that took place last week.

On August 24, 2021, just after 8:45 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 6600 block of Union Avenue at the Woodlawn Terrace Apartments on reports of a shooting. Arriving officers located a woman inside of her apartment suffering from a gunshot wound to the leg. The Shreveport Fire Department transported her to Ochsner LSU Health Hospital for non-life-threatening injuries. She is expected to recover.

Violent Crimes detectives were summoned and immediately launched their investigation. They canvassed the neighborhood and interviewed on-scene witnesses while Crime Scene Investigators collected evidence.

Detectives worked through the week. Through their investigation they learned that Everett Henderson (5-10-2001) and a 16-year-old male juvenile were involved in a dispute over a narcotic transaction. The 16-year-old and Henderson exchanged gunfire and subsequently struck the victim, who was lying in her bed. She was not affiliated with either individual. The shots were fired outside of the apartment building; however, the bullets penetrated the structure and struck the victim.

Henderson was taken into custody on August 25, 2021 and booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Illegal Use of a Weapon. The 16-year-old juvenile was taken into custody on August 30, 2021 and charged with one count of Attempted Second Degree Murder. No further details will be released as this matter is still under investigation and pending adjudication.
