Shreveport Police make arrest in connection with body found in Lake Bistineau

On October 10, 2021, Bossier Parish Sheriff's Office responded to reports of a body found in Lake Bistineau. The decedent was identified as Shreveport resident, Borris Williams (8-1-1997). Williams had multiple gunshot injuries to his body and an investigation was launched immediately.

Detectives worked through the day and night to develop information that ultimately led them to the crime scene which was a residence in the 3000 block of Lufkin Street, inside the city limits of Shreveport. Crime Scene Investigators processed that residence and photographed and collected multiple items of evidentiary value. Detectives canvassed the neighborhood and spoke with witnesses who provided information relative to the homicide. Through those interviews and other investigative techniques, detectives identified Reginald Grant, 4-5-1997, as the person believed to be responsible for William's death. They learned that the two men lived together in the residence on Lufkin Street. Detectives have not any released information regarding the motive for the murder.

Grant was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Second-Degree Murder and one count of Convicted Felon in Possession of a Firearm following interviews with our investigative team.
