**Arrest made in early October murder attempt**

On October 3, 2021, just before 1:30 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of shots fired in the 2900 block of Hattie Street. Arriving officers made contact with the victim who advised that a known male fired multiple shots at him.

Detectives with the Violent Crimes Unit were assigned to follow up on the incident. On October 3, 2021, they were able to procure an arrest warrant charging Michael Sherman (3-12-1997) with one count of Attempted Second Degree Murder.

On October 31, 2021, Sherman was taken into custody by Shreveport Police patrol officers. Detectives executed a search warrant on his residence and located the handgun believed to have been used in the murder attempt, along with a stolen handgun. Sherman was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on the murder warrant.

On November 2, 2021, detectives added additional charges to Sherman stemming from the evidence discovered during the execution of the search warrant and from information gathered during the ongoing investigation into the attempted murder. He was charged with one count each of Illegal Possession of Firearm by Convicted Felon, Illegal Possession of a Stolen Firearm, Possession of a Schedule I Narcotic with the Intent to Distribute, and Illegal Carrying of a Weapon with a Controlled Dangerous Substance. Sherman was also charged with 2 counts of Possession of a Schedule II Narcotic with the Intent to Distribute.
