### **Arrest made in Peach Street homicide**

On November 16, 2021, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to a shooting in 2900 block of Peach Street. On arrival, they located 23-years-old Jamar Norris suffering from at least two gunshot injuries to his upper body. He was transported to a local hospital where he later died.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit responded and launched their investigation. CSIU photographed the scene and collected multiple items of evidence. Following interviews with witnesses, detectives were able to identify the suspect as James Stubblefield 3-28-1966.

Detectives learned that Jamar Norris and his estranged girlfriend were engaged in a verbal argument over child custody and at some point during the argument, Stubblefield produced a handgun and shot Norris at least twice. Stubblefield fled to Ardmore, Oklahoma after the shooting. Detectives with the homicide unit procured a warrant for Stubblefield charging him with one count of Second-Degree Murder. No bond was set.

On November 17, 2021, Stubblefield was taken into custody by the US Marshals Violent Offenders Task Force and Ardmore Police. He is awaiting extradition back to Caddo Parish.
