Shreveport man charged with two sexual assaults



Jimmy Foster, Jr.

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Sex Crimes Unit have charged a man in two separate sexual assault incidents.

On June 24, 2021, a juvenile disclosed that they were sexually assaulted in east Shreveport. Evidence was collected from the victim following the assault. On December 13, 2021, detectives were notified by the North Louisiana Criminalistics Lab that the DNA evidence submitted by detectives was matched to Jimmy Foster Jr. (8-10-1983).

On December 14, 2021, Detectives procured a warrant for Foster charging him with one count of First-Degree Rape. No bond was set. Shortly after the warrant was issued detectives learned that Foster was at a west Shreveport location. Patrol officers responded quickly and took Foster into custody without incident. He was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.

On December 11, 2021, Sex Crimes Investigators were called to investigate allegations of an adult victim disclosing that they had been held at gunpoint and sexually assaulted by Jimmy Foster Jr. (8-10-1983). Detectives contacted Foster at Caddo Correctional Center and charged him with one count of First-Degree Rape. He remains at the Caddo Correctional Center.
