Suspect arrested in Madison Avenue murder

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Investigators have jailed a man in connection with yesterday's mid-morning homicide in North Shreveport.

On December 23, just before 10:00 a.m. Shreveport Police Patrol units responded to a convenience store in the 1500 block of Madison Avenue on reports of a shooting. Arriving officers located a man lying on the ground suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Shreveport Fire Department transported the man to Ochsner University for additional medical treatment and was pronounced deceased a short time later. The man was later identified as 20-year-old Katrayvon B. Hill.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit and Crime Scene Units were summoned to the scene. Crime Scene investigators documented the scene and collected all items of evidentiary value while investigators combed through video surveillance footage and interviewed witnesses. Through their investigation, they learned that Hill and his cousin, Armand Burgy (4-6-1992), were involved in a dispute over money. Both were armed with firearms.

Burgy left the scene only to return a short time later and shoot him multiple times. He fled the scene but was taken into custody by patrol officers a short time later and transported to the Shreveport Police Complex. Following interviews, detectives procured a warrant charging Burgy with one count of Second-Degree Murder. Bond was set at \$1,000,000.00. He was also charged with one count each of Second-Degree Robbery, Convicted Felon with a Firearm, Illegal Possession of a Stolen Firearm, Obstruction of Justice, and Domestic Abuse Battery Strangulation (from a non-related domestic incident prior to the homicide). Burgy was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
