Arrest made in early morning homicide

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Investigators have charged a man with murder following an early morning fatal shooting in west Shreveport.

On February 15, 2022, just before 4:00 a.m., Shreveport Police Patrol officers responded to reports of a shooting at the Economy Inn in the 5100 block of Westwood Park Drive. Arriving officers located a man suffering from multiple gunshot injuries. The man was transported to a local hospital where he later died.

SPD Dispatch received a description of the suspect vehicle, a black Jeep SUV, and relayed that information to responding officers. Officers did locate that vehicle on the parking lot and contacted the driver, Romullus Noyes (9-23-1999). Officers detained Noyes and contacted investigators.

Investigators responded and spoke with witnesses and collected items of evidentiary value, including video. Detectives learned that the victim and another person were involved in a dispute that turned physical. Noyes interjected himself into the physical encounter, produced a handgun, shot the victim multiple times, then ran over the victim with his SUV.

Noyes was transported to the Shreveport Police Complex and following interviews was charged with one count of Second-Degree Murder. He was booked into the Shreveport City Jail and no bond has been set.
