## **Man charged in connection with murder at local convenience store**

On February 15, 2022, just after 1:30 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the Village Food Mart in the 5300 block of Jewella Avenue on reports of a shooting. Arriving officers located 29-year-old Roderick D. Walker inside of the store suffering from at least one gunshot wound to the chest. The Shreveport Fire Department transported Walker to a local hospital where he later died.

Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Investigators were summoned to the scene and launched their investigations. CSIU collected evidence, including video, while detectives interviewed witnesses. Investigators learned the Walker and Damion Sherfield (7-29-2001) engaged in a dispute inside of the convenience store. During the dispute, Sherfield produced a firearm and shot Walker. At this time, detectives do not believe the two men knew each other.

Sherfield surrendered himself to Violent Crimes investigators late yesterday afternoon. He was interviewed by detectives then booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Second-Degree Murder.

The investigation is still ongoing.
