Arrest made in Barbara Avenue homicide

Police have a man under arrest following a shooting early yesterday morning in west Shreveport.

On February 17, 2021, just after 9:40 a.m. Shreveport Police received reports of a robbery and shots fired in the 4200 block of Barbara Avenue. Arriving officers located 25-year-old Regmond Mitchell in a black sedan in the block. He had been shot at least once in the head and was pronounced deceased on scene by the Shreveport Fire Department.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime scene units were summoned. CSIU collected evidence and photographed the scene and detectives began interviewing witnesses and canvassing the neighborhood. Officers were originally told that Mitchell had attempted to rob a woman and man at a residence in the block. Through witness interviews and other investigative factors detectives learned that Mitchell and Ernie Campbell (10-18-1983) were engaging in a narcotics transaction and during that transaction, Campbell produced a weapon and shot Mitchell at least once in the head. Detectives believe that Campbell and others fabricated the robbery story in an attempt to conceal the crime.

Following interviews with investigators, Campbell was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Second-Degree Murder and an outstanding warrant for Aggravated Battery stemming from a 2021 Aggravated Battery where he was accused of striking another man with a firearm causing serious injuries. No bond has been set on the murder and bond was set at \$50,000 on the Aggravated Battery.
