No major incidents reported at Krewe of Centaur parade

The Krewe of Centaur parade returned to Shreveport following a break in 2021, due to COVID-19. The City of Shreveport and partnering agencies hosted a successful event for thousands of spectators.

The Shreveport Police Department reported no major incidents and only one arrest. The Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office, Louisiana State Police and the City Marshal's Office worked together as a team to provide security. SPD's auxiliary officers played a vital role in providing support to law enforcement agencies. The same group will staff the Krewe of Gemini parade on Saturday, February 26.

The Department of Public Works deployed five garbage trucks to barricade major roadways. This measure offsets costs for additional personnel.
