Police investigate early morning homicide in west Shreveport

On April 17, 2022, just before 1:00 a.m., Shreveport Police Patrol Officers were dispatched to reports of shots fired at the intersection of Corbitt Street and Mansfield Road. Arriving officers located a black Dodge Challenger that had crashed into a utility pole. Inside, they discovered a female suffering from multiple gunshot injuries. The Shreveport Fire Department pronounced the woman dead on the scene.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene units were summoned. CSIU collected evidence and Violent Crimes detectives combed the area for witnesses and video.

The Caddo Parish Coroner's Office responded and took possession of the decedent.

The investigation is still underway.

They will pay a minimum of \$2,000.00 for information relative to this incident.
