Dear Mr. Vanroosendaal,

On April 18, 2022, you applied for a Vehicle for Hire License. This correspondence is to inform you that your application for Vehicle for Hire has been denied. The denial is because you did not meet all the requirements as outlined by City Ordinance 102-62:

Section 102-62: Qualification of Applicant:

Each applicant for a vehicle for hire driver's license shall certify that he meets the following qualifications:

(3) He has not been convicted of any other felony or of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude defined for the purpose of this article as a long or repetitive history of violence or criminal behavior, against the criminal laws of this state, has not served any part of a sentence therefore within five years before the date of the filing of the application, and he is not presently charged therewith, or with any of the felonies, offenses or misdemeanors set forth in subsection (2) of this section (excepting minor traffic violations), or with violating any of the provisions of this article.

Section 102-46 of the City Ordinance does, however provide for an appeal to the City Council for approval or disapproval. You are eligible to reapply with the understanding that no additional negative activity reflects your record.

Should you desire to appeal this decision, you must file a written appeal in the office of the Clerk of Council, 505 Travis Street, Suite 410. The telephone number is 318-673-5262. All pertinent information, including but not limited to your criminal history will be disclosed at the public hearing.
