Suspect sought in late March Homicide

On Monday, March 29th, 2022, at 11:30 a.m., Shreveport Police Department Patrol officers responded to the 8200 block of Pines Road on reports of a deceased person inside of a white Dodge Challenger that was parked on the apartment complex property. Arriving Officers located a Black male who appeared to be in his 20's inside of the vehicle, he had suffered at least one gunshot injury to the upper body and was pronounced deceased on scene by the Shreveport Fire Department.

Detectives with the Violent Crimes Unit responded to the scene and through interviews with witnesses and examination of evidence, they identified the suspected shooter as Zacorius Williams (1/17/2001). An arrest warrant was obtained for Williams charging him with 2nd Degree Murder.

A cash reward will be paid for information leading to Williams's arrest.
