Two men wanted in connection to a weekend shooting

On Saturday April 30th, 2022, at 3:00 p.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to the 200 block of Prospect Street on reports of a shooting. Arriving officers located a man inside of a vehicle that was suffering from at least one gunshot wound to the upper body. The victim was transported to a local hospital with what was described as life threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units were summoned to the scene. CSIU collected items of evidence and investigators canvassed the neighborhood searching for witnesses and video.

Through their on-going investigation detectives were able to obtain information that led them to the development of two suspects. On May 1st, 2022, Detectives obtained warrants charging Elijah Williams (6/8/99) with Principal to Attempted 1st Degree Murder and Thomas Office(12/15/2001) with Attempted 1st Degree Murder.

Investigators consider these individuals to be armed and dangerous. If you have information on the whereabouts of these alleged offenders, please contact Shreveport Police at 318-673-7300 #3.

Shreveport Caddo Crime Stoppers is offering a minimum reward of \$2,000.00 for any information leading to the identification and arrest of the individual(s) responsible for this crime. The victim in this case has succumbed to his injuries. Detectives have obtained warrants upgrading the charges on the suspects. Detectives obtained warrants charging Elijah Williams (6/8/99) with Principal to 1st Degree Murder and Thomas Office (12/15/2001) with 1st Degree Murder.

Elijah Williams was taken into custody on June 11th in Houston, TX for his warrant. Thomas Office is still outstanding.
