Line Avenue road rage shooting

On June 25th, 2022, Shreveport Police Department Patrol officers responded to the 5800 block of Line Avenue on reports of a shooting that had just occurred. Responding officers located a male suffering from a gunshot wound. That man was identified as Donald Gonsoulin. Donald was transported to Ochsner Health Hospital by Shreveport Fire Department with non-life-threatening injuries.

Officers then contacted a separate male who advised that he was the person responsible for this shooting. The male was identified as Harry Dubin.

Detectives with the Violent Crimes unit responded to the scene and began their investigation. It was then determined that this shooting stemmed from a road rage incident.

Reportedly Donald Gonsoulin exited his vehicle and charged at Harry Dublin's vehicle a first time at a red light on Line Avenue. He then confronted Dublin a second time in the Brookshire's Parking lot. Allegedly Gonsoulin attempted to get inside Dublin's vehicle, and Dubin shot Gonsoulin once. No arrests are expected to be made.
