Two suspects wanted in shooting that injures women



On August 21st, 2022, Shreveport Police officers were called to the 2600 block of Myrtle Avenue in reference to a shooting. Arriving officers located a 32-year-old female suffering from gunshot injuries to her hand and neck. The victim was transported to a local area hospital where she was treated for non-life-threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units were summoned to the crime scene. CSIU collected items of evidence and investigators canvassed the neighborhood searching for witnesses and video. Detectives were able to determine that there were multiple suspects involved in the incident.

Detectives identified one of the possible suspects as Deshawn Kemp (10/22/91) and a warrant for one count for illegal use of a firearm was obtained for his arrest.

During the investigation detectives obtained security footage of another possible suspect. That footage is being released to the public in hopes of identifying the man offense.
