Progress has been made in water system repairs

Repairs have now been completed at two of the sites with damaged structures.

- Linwood water tank at the corner of Flournoy Lucas Road and Stevens Road
 - Pictures of the repairs and a water sampling plan were submitted to the Louisiana Department of Health. That plan was approved by LDH and now water samples will be tested. Once those results have been analyzed and cleared the boil advisory for that area can be rescinded.
- The elevated ground storage site at 70th and Pines Road
 - Department of Water and Sewerage is in the process of sending pictures of the repairs and water sampling plan to LDH for approval.

The media will be given an opportunity to get video and photos of the repairs at the St. Vincent water tower.
