Water System Repairs Completed and Boil Advisory Lifted for Southeast Zone

A system-wide boil advisory remains in effect for most of Shreveport, however, it has been rescinded for the Southeast zone. That includes customers to the south of East Bert Kouns, some subdivisions along Linwood Avenue south of Bert Kouns, and the area southeast of the Interstate 49 and 3132 interchange.

The Department of Water and Sewerage says repairs at four sites have been completed. Work ended just before noon on the West Shreveport elevated tank and the Louisiana Department of Health has given its approval for water sampling to begin in that area.

Crews finished repairs on Thursday, September 1, 2022, at the St. Vincent water tower, the Linwood water tank, and the elevated ground storage site at 70th and Pines Road. Water sampling began when the work was completed. Water Department staff collected samples through the night and once analyzed LDH could rescind the boil advisory for the other two zones.
