Man arrested in road rage shooting

On September 15th, 2022, at 8:00 a.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to a shooting at West 70th and Terry Bradshaw Pass Way.

While responding, officers were notified that the victim drove to a local area hospital and was suffering from a non-life-threatening gunshot wound to the leg.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units were summoned to the scene. Through their on-going investigation, detectives were able to determine that the victim was driving on Buncombe Road, when a beige Malibu attempted to get over in traffic reportedly cutting him off. The Malibu then allegedly followed the victim to 3132 and fired numerous shots into the victim's vehicle, striking him in the lower body.

Jaylen Stewart (4-01-01) was identified by Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Detectives as the suspect in this case. On September 16th, Jaylen Stewart was taken into custody and charged with one count of attempted second degree murder.

Due to the new laws issued in reference to mugshot releases in the state of Louisiana we are asked to remind that all suspects are innocent until proven guilty.
