**Property Standards sweep targets District D**

The Department of Property Standards is holding its next sweep in District D on Wednesday, November 2, 2022. From 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. citizens can bring trash, debris, and tires for disposal to A.B. Palmer Recreation Center at 547 E. 79<sup>th</sup> Street.

The Shreveport Police Department will be citing property owners for yard parking and other violations. Inspectors will be concentrated in the Cedar Grove and Springlake neighborhoods and will be flagging structures for demolition.

The Shreveport-Caddo Metropolitan Planning Commission Zoning Enforcement staff will be checking for businesses operating illegally and other zoning issues.

The next sweep is scheduled for November 9, 2022, in District E.
