Man arrested in Nash Street Shooting

On January 26th, 2023, at 9:00 p.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to a shooting in the 1700 block of Nash Street.

Arriving officers found that a vehicle had driven by a residence in the 1700 block of Nash Street and discharged a firearm at the victim and the victim's family members. No one was injured in this incident however further investigation revealed that the victim, in this case, was one of the family members of the Sugar Lane Shooting that happened on January 22, 2023, that resulted in a homicide.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units were summoned to the scene. Through their ongoing investigation detectives were able to obtain information that led them to determine that Marquez Wilson (05/06/87) was allegedly responsible for the shooting.

On January 31st, 2023, Marquez Wilson was booked in at the Shreveport City Jail on one count of attempted 1st-degree murder.

Investigation into the Homicide on Sugar Lane is still open and investigators with the Shreveport Police Department are asking the public for assistance.
