**Six were arrested for DWI within hours**

In the early morning hours of March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Shreveport Police Patrol officers made six DWI arrests.

The first occurred around 2:00 a.m. when officers contacted Kennedi Marshall (2-8-01) as she was reported asleep behind the wheel of her vehicle in the 1200 block of South Pointe Drive. She was arrested and charged with one count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated.

The second occurred at 2:15 a.m. as officers contacted Alston Brooks (1-8-88). Brooks was reported found asleep behind the wheel of the vehicle with the vehicle parked on the curb of Elvis Presley Boulevard and Texas Street. He was arrested and charged with one count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated,

The third arrest came after officers contacted Javeus Johnson (7-20-93) at 2:19 a.m. Johnson was contacted during a traffic stop in the 400 block of Market street. As officers approached, he was reportedly intoxicated. He was arrested and charged with one count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated.

The fourth arrest came after officers contacted Kenneth Jones (9-25-72) at 2:41 a.m. Jones was contacted when officers responded to a call of an audible alarm going off in the 1300 block of Jewella Avenue. As officers approached it was determined that the vehicle had been in an accident. The front end was damaged, and airbags were deployed. Jones was reportedly intoxicated. He was arrested and charged with one count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated.

The fifth arrest came after officers contacted Charles Warren (7-3-72) at 3:31 a.m. Warren was contacted when officers responded to a call about an automobile accident in the 6000 block of Bert Kouns Industrial Loop. As officers approached Warren he was reportedly intoxicated. He was arrested and charged with one count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated.

The sixth arrest came after officers contacted Leavern Johnson (1-6-96) at 4:25 a.m. Johnson was contacted during a traffic stop at Interstate 49 and Market Street. As officers approached, she was reportedly intoxicated. She was arrested and charged with one count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated.
