Mayor Arceneaux announces today the 2023 Summer Youth Employment and Training Program (SYETP)

The 2023 Summer Youth Employment and Training Program, (SYETP) will employ residents of the City of Shreveport, aged 17 to 22. Participants earn \$10.00 per hour and work 30 hours weekly for six weeks.

The program is scheduled to start on June 5, 2023, and end on July 14, 2023. Summer workers are required to receive an individual program orientation conducted by the City of Shreveport's Department of Community Development—Workforce Bureau staff before reporting to work.

Participants will work across a wide variety of City departments or for various private businesses. Summer workers will be exposed to life skills and soft skills, professional development, career exploration, and the chance to develop good work habits that will prepare them to be the future leaders of Shreveport.
