Convicted felon with a firearm arrest

On May 5th, 2023, at 3:11 p.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to a call from a female saying she was being threatened by a man with a gun in the 3800 block of Oak Crest Street. On arrival, the responding officers learned that a male identified as James Perot (12-19-2002) reportedly had beaten the woman and then threatened her at gunpoint.

Officers found that Perot had been threatening her while armed with a gun. The victim also had injuries consistent with the statement given. Perot was charged with one count of Aggravated assault with a firearm, one count of aggravated domestic abuse, one count of domestic abuse battery with child endangerment, and one count of property damage.

During this Investigation, officers also encountered Jarvis Perot (11-22-99) and found him to possess a firearm. Further investigation into the matter revealed that Jarvis Perot was prohibited from possessing a firearm due to being a convicted felon for prior felony offenses.

The firearm and narcotics were seized by the officers and Jarvis Perot was arrested for one count of being a convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

We are required to advise that all suspects are innocent until proven guilty.
