Three were arrested with firearms and narcotics

On June 6th, 2023, around 4:03 p.m. Shreveport Police Patrol Officers conducted a traffic stop in the 5100 block of Jefferson Paige Road. Officers contacted Jermaine Robinson (6-11-80), Richard Perrow (10-31-96), and Marcus Ester (1-29-98) inside the vehicle. Officers found that the men were in possession of narcotics. The officers detained the suspects and discovered that Ester and Perrow were armed with handguns.

Further investigation into the matter revealed that Perrow was prohibited from possessing a firearm due to being a convicted felon for prior felony offenses. Perrow was arrested on one count of being a convicted felon in possession of a firearm, Possession with intent to distribute Schedule One, and possession of a firearm in the presence of a controlled dangerous substance.

Ester was arrested on one count of Possession with intent to distribute Schedule One and possession of a firearm in the presence of a controlled dangerous substance.

Robinson was arrested on one count of Possession with intent to distribute Schedule One and an outstanding warrant for a narcotics offense. The firearms and narcotics were seized as evidence.

We are required to advise that all suspects are innocent until proven guilty. Robinson's and Ester's photos are not releasable due to their charges not being classified as a violent offense under LA RS 14:2.
