A water main was shut off for field work on Wednesday, October 4, 2023, at approximately 3:00p.m, thereby affecting:

9300 Linwood, 9200-9300 Briarcrest Trail, 400-500 Blk Kennie Road, 400 blk Brushy Bayou Blvd, 500 Blk Astor Place, 9200-9300 Mykanos Trail, and 400 blk Winnewood.

When repairs are complete, the water supplied by our distribution system to your facility may be of questionable microbiological quality. Therefore, as a precaution, the Department of Water & Sewerage is issuing a VOLUNTARY BOIL ADVISORY effective when service is restored, until sample(s) collected and analyzed indicate the absence of coliform bacteria.

It is recommended that water be disinfected before consuming it (including fountain drinks), making ice, brushing teeth, or using it for food preparation or rinsing of foods by the following means:

Boil water for one (1) full minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. (The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle or pouring it from one clean container to another)

When satisfactory laboratory test results are obtained, the Department of Water & Sewerage with approval from the Louisiana Department of Health, will then rescind the Boil Advisory and notify you that the water has been deemed safe.
