BOIL WATER ADVISORY HAS BEEN LIFTED

At **2:50 PM** today, the Louisiana Department of Health lifted the boil advisory issued on **10/04/2023** for customers in the following areas:

9300 Linwood, 9200-9300 Briarcrest Trail, 400-500 Blk Kennie Road, 400 blk Brushy Bayou Blvd, 500 Blk Astor Place, 9200-9300 Mykanos Trail, and 400 blk Winnewood.

The samples collected and analyzed from this area were shown to be absent of any coliform bacteriological contamination. After receiving the analytical results, an official of the Louisiana Department of Health approved the rescission of the voluntary boil water advisory. Those customers may now resume the normal use of their water supplied by the City of Shreveport.
