

Police Ask Public For Information Regarding West Shreveport Homicide

Shreveport Police are investigating what has now been determined to be a homicide in west Shreveport.

On October 26, 2023, just after 2:30 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 400 block of Argyle Street on reports of a deceased person. Officers located a black female behind a residence in the block. Officers established a perimeter and called for detectives with the Violent Crimes Crime Scene Units.

The CSIU collected evidence and violent crimes detectives canvassed the neighborhood and interviewed neighbors. Due to the condition of the woman's remains and no identification card being located, they were unable to immediately identify the decedent. An autopsy was performed this morning and it was determined that the decedent had sustained severe blunt force trauma to her face. The Caddo Parish Coroner's Office will release the decedent's name at a later time.

The investigation is ongoing and detectives are asking anyone with information to contact them at 318-673-7300 #3. Those wishing to submit information anonymously are asked to contact Caddo-Shreveport Crime Stoppers through their app, P3Tips, or via phone at 318-673-7373. Crime Stoppers will pay a minimum of \$2,000.00 for information leading to the arrest of the person(s) responsible for this crime. Remember, Crime Stoppers only wants your information, not your name.

The investigation is ongoing.
