The City of Shreveport's Department of Water and Sewerage is urging residents to limit non-essential water use following three days of extreme winter weather. The weather-related issues have not allowed us to replenish water reserves, potentially causing lower-than-normal water pressure today.

As the city experiences colder temperatures, residents need to be mindful of their water usage. The Department of Water and Sewerage advises all customers to refrain from non-essential water activities to ensure that the water supply remains sufficient for essential needs.

Additionally, residents are reminded to turn off any faucets that may be left dripping, especially with temperatures expected to rise above freezing this afternoon. Taking this simple step will contribute significantly to the conservation of water resources.
