Police Search For Man Wanted In Connection To A Domestic Related Home Invasion



On January 4, 2024, investigators with the Domestic Violence Unit were assigned to follow up on a reported battery. Detectives learned that Deatrick Brown (12-12-1986), allegedly entered a window at the victim's home and began punching her about her head multiple times with a closed fist. After the beating, Brown fled the scene prior to officer's arrival.

Detectives were able to make contact with Brown, who told them he moved to Houston, Texas. He did not surrender himself as asked, so on January 26, 2024, investigators procured a warrant for Brown's arrest, charging him with one count of Home Invasion. No Bond was set.

Chief Wayne Smith and the Shreveport Police Department reminds our community that domestic violence is extremely dangerous and urges anyone in that believes that they are in danger to call us. We can help. Through our partnerships with local advocacy groups and the victim's assistance team at the District Attorney's Office, we can get people the help they need to escape danger.
