**Arrest In Domestic Incident**

On February 4, 2024, at approximately 11:40 A.M., Shreveport Police responded to a distress call in the 1100 block of Boulevard Street regarding a domestic incident. Upon arrival, officers discovered a concerning situation involving 36-year-old Jeremy Long, who allegedly locked the victim in a room during a physical struggle. Disturbingly, this incident unfolded in the presence of three children.

Jeremy Long has been apprehended and is now facing charges, including one count of false imprisonment, one count of felony domestic abuse battery, and three counts of domestic abuse battery with child endangerment.

The accused is currently in custody, and the legal process will proceed. Shreveport Police Department urges domestic abuse victims to seek support and take appropriate measures to safeguard the welfare of children involved in these cases.

The incident serves as a reminder of the importance of reporting domestic disturbances promptly. We encourage anyone experiencing or witnessing such situations to reach out to local law enforcement for assistance.
