Arrest Made in Domestic Violence Incident

Detectives from the Shreveport Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit have apprehended Dennis Mason, aged 35, in connection with a domestic abuse aggravated assault case. Mason is accused of threatening the victim on multiple occasions with a knife, prompting action from the Shreveport Police Department.

The arrest took place in the early hours of February 13th, at approximately 2:20 A.M., in the 200 block of Prospect Street, following coordinated efforts between officers and detectives. The Shreveport Police Department is committed to swiftly addressing incidents of domestic violence and ensuring the safety and well-being of all individuals involved.

The Shreveport Police Department takes all reports of domestic violence seriously. Chief Wayne Smith wants citizens to know that our dedicated detectives work tirelessly to hold perpetrators accountable and provide support to victims.

The Shreveport Police Department urges anyone who may have other instances of domestic violence to come forward and assist in the ongoing efforts to combat this pervasive issue in our community.
