**Arrest Made In Felony Domestic Incident Involving A Firearm-
CORRECTED MUG**

At approximately 3:17 a.m. on February 18th, officers responded to a domestic disturbance in the 2600 block of Lyles Lane where the suspect was reportedly armed with a firearm. Following an initial investigation, 42-year-old Timothy Washington was arrested in connection with the incident.

Washington faces charges including one count of domestic abuse battery with strangulation, one count of domestic abuse aggravated assault, one count of interfering with the use of 911, and one count of being a felon in possession of a firearm.

Fortunately, the victim was not seriously injured and is expected to recover fully.

The Shreveport Police Department emphasizes its commitment to addressing incidents of domestic violence and ensuring the safety and well-being of all community members.

The Shreveport Police Department urges anyone who may have other instances of domestic violence to come forward and assist in the ongoing efforts to combat this pervasive issue in our community.

We are required to remind that all suspects are innocent until found guilty.
