Man Wanted In Fatal Crash

Shreveport Police Department's crash investigators are actively seeking 47-year-old Scott Millis in connection with a tragic incident that occurred on January 11, 2024. Millis is wanted in relation to a fatal crash that resulted in the loss of a life.

The incident unfolded on January 11, when officers responded to a two-vehicle collision at the intersection of North Market and Poleman Road. Both vehicles involved sustained significant damage, indicating the severity of the collision.

After meticulous investigation and gathering of evidence, crash investigators have determined the culpability of Scott Millis in this devastating incident. Consequently, warrants have been issued for Millis' arrest on charges of one count of vehicular homicide and one count of first-degree vehicular negligent injury.

The Shreveport Police Department urges anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of Scott Millis to come forward and assist in the swift resolution of this case.
