Second man arrested in shooting that resulted in the Death of a One-Year-Old Child

Detectives from the Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Unit have made a significant breakthrough in the case concerning the shooting that claimed the life of a one-year-old child on February 11th in the 500 block of East Stoner Avenue.

Through relentless investigation and unwavering dedication, authorities have Laterrion Watts, 23 years of age, on charges of second-degree murder in connection with this senseless act. This arrest represents a critical step forward in holding those responsible accountable for their actions.

The Shreveport Police Violent Crime Detectives continue to tirelessly pursue leads and gather evidence to ensure that all individuals involved in this tragic incident are brought to justice. Further arrests are anticipated as the investigation progresses.

As we move forward, we urge the public to come forward with any information that may aid in this investigation. It is through the collaboration of law enforcement and the community that we can ensure justice is served and prevent such heinous acts of violence from occurring in the future.
