Arrest Made in Domestic Violence Shooting Incident

The Shreveport Police Department responded to a shooting incident on February 17th at approximately 2:30 AM in the 9200 block of Wallace Lake Road. Officers responded to reports of a shooting, where a victim had been transported to a local area hospital with a gunshot wound to the leg.

Upon arrival, detectives from the Shreveport Police Domestic Violence Unit commenced their investigation into the matter. Their diligent efforts led to the apprehension of Brekiscus Jackson, aged 51, on February 21st. Jackson faces charges including one count of aggravated battery and one count of illegal use of a weapon in connection with the incident.

Fortunately, the victim is expected to make a full recovery.

The Shreveport Police Department remains steadfast in its commitment to ensuring the safety and well-being of all residents, particularly in cases of domestic violence. We urge anyone experiencing domestic violence or witnessing such incidents to reach out for assistance.

All suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty under state law.
