Arrest Made In Fatal Stabbing Incident On Rose Hollow Lane

On April 7, just after midnight, officers from the Shreveport Police Department responded to a call regarding a stabbing incident in the 9500 block of Rose Hollow Lane. Upon arrival, officers discovered a male victim with a life-threatening stab wound to the chest. Despite immediate medical attention and transportation to a local area hospital, the victim succumbed to his injuries.

Subsequent investigation by detectives from the Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Unit revealed that the incident stemmed from a domestic dispute. It was determined that Shemike Johnson, 43 years old, allegedly perpetrated the stabbing.

As a result of the investigation, Johnson has been arrested and charged with one count of second-degree murder in connection with this tragic event.

As always, we remind the public to prioritize safety and seek assistance from authorities or support services in situations of domestic conflict.

The Shreveport Police Department urges anyone who may have other instances of domestic violence to come forward and assist in the ongoing efforts to combat this pervasive issue in our community.

We are required to remind that all suspects are innocent until found guilty.
