The 2024 Summer Youth Employment and Training Program, (SYETP) will employ residents of the City of Shreveport, aged 17 to 22. Participants earn \$10.00 per hour and will work 30 hours weekly for six weeks.

The program is scheduled to start on June 3, 2024, and end on July 12, 2024. Summer workers are required to receive an individual program orientation conducted by the City of Shreveport Department of Community Development – Workforce Bureau staff before reporting to work.
