**Shreveport Police Canine Unit Arrests Convicted Felon in Possession of Firearm  
and Narcotics**

On April 24, at approximately 3:30 AM, an SPD canine unit conducted a traffic stop that resulted in the arrest of a convicted felon in possession of a firearm. During the stop, officers encountered 38-year-old Dennis Robinson, who was found to be in possession of multiple types of narcotics along with a firearm.

Robinson has been charged with several offenses, including manufacturing and distribution of scheduled narcotics, three counts of possession of scheduled narcotics, possession of drug paraphernalia, and one count of being a convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

We commend the dedication and swift action of our officers in apprehending individuals who pose a risk to public safety. The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to combating illegal activities and maintaining the security of our neighborhoods.

We are required to remind that all suspects are innocent until found guilty.
