**Arrest Made in First-Degree Rape Case**

The Shreveport Police Department's Sex Crimes Unit has apprehended John Taylor, a 40-year-old resident, in connection with a case of sexual assault. Taylor stands accused of first-degree rape and simple battery, specifically involving the alleged sexual assault of a child under the age of 10.
