Stolen Vehicle Investigation Leads to Felon Arrest

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Property Crimes Unit have made significant progress in an investigation into a stolen vehicle that occurred on May 18th in the 6900 block of West Bert Kouns Industrial Loop.

The investigation led officers to a residence in the 3400 block of Jackson Street, where 40-year-old Tiffany Starling was arrested for the theft of a motor vehicle.

During the investigation, detectives also discovered 42-year-old Edward McIntyre at the residence. McIntyre was found to be in possession of eight firearms. Further investigation revealed that McIntyre is a convicted felon, making it illegal for him to possess firearms.

As a result of this investigation, all firearms were seized, and the stolen vehicle was returned to its owner. Chief Smith praises the dedication of these officers, who continue to work tirelessly to ensure the safety of our community.

Suspects are innocent until proven guilty.
