Shreveport Police Arrest Man After High-Speed Chase in Stolen Vehicle

On May 23, at approximately 12:20 p.m., Shreveport Police officers attempted to stop a stolen vehicle at the intersection of East 70th Street and Fern Avenue. The driver, however, refused to comply, leading officers on a high-speed pursuit.

The chase concluded when the suspect crashed the vehicle on Youree Drive, south of Bert Kouns Industrial Loop. Despite the severity of the situation, no serious injuries were reported.

The suspect, identified as 28-year-old Daniel McCraven, has been arrested and charged with the following:

- One count of illegal felony possession of stolen things
- One count of aggravated flight from an officer
- Operating a vehicle without a license

The Shreveport Police Department is relieved that no one was harmed during the incident and commends the officers for their action in apprehending the suspect.

Suspects are innocent until proven guilty.
