Councilwoman Tabatha Taylor Reminds Residents of Impending Utility Cut-Off at Villa Norte Apartments

SHREVEPORT, LA - Councilwoman Tabatha Taylor of District A reminds the residents of Villa Norte Apartments and other affected complexes of the impending utility cut-off scheduled for Friday, May 31, 2024. This cut-off is a critical matter that requires immediate attention and action from all residents.

Councilwoman Taylor strongly encourages residents to contact Providence House for relocation information and assistance. Providence House is available to provide support and can be reached at 318-221-7887.

"I urge all residents to make necessary preparations and reach out to Providence House as soon as possible," said Councilwoman Taylor. "It's crucial that everyone affected by this situation has access to the resources and assistance they need."

Councilwoman Taylor and stakeholders will do another walkthrough prior to the May 31 date. In addition, Councilwoman Taylor calls on relatives and friends to check on and assist those living in Villa Norte Apartments and other affected complexes during this challenging time. Ensuring the safety and well-being of our community members is a shared responsibility.

Councilwoman Taylor also commends the administration's ongoing efforts to eliminate blight in our community. She is committed to working closely with the administration to hold absentee slumlords accountable for the inhumane conditions that have led to this unfortunate situation.

"We will address the root causes of these issues and ensure that all Shreveport residents have safe and dignified living conditions," Taylor emphasized. Councilwoman Taylor thanks those non-profits, companies, citizens, and everyone who has responded to this humanitarian crisis. "Together, we can make a difference and build a better community for everyone."
