**Shreveport Police Investigate Officer-Involved Crash That Fatally Injures  
Pedestrian**

The Shreveport Police Department (SPD) is currently investigating an officer-involved crash that resulted in the fatal injury of a pedestrian. The incident occurred on June 20, 2024, at approximately 1:02 a.m.

A SPD patrol officer was driving a patrol unit eastbound in the 600 block of East 70th Street. While crossing the intersection of Line Avenue, the officer struck a pedestrian who was present in the roadway. The Shreveport Fire Department responded promptly to the scene and transported the pedestrian to a nearby hospital. Unfortunately, the pedestrian succumbed to his injuries shortly after arriving at the hospital.

The Shreveport Police Crash Investigations unit was immediately dispatched to the scene and began a thorough investigation. Preliminary findings indicate that the pedestrian was in the roadway and dressed in dark clothing at the time of the incident. Additionally, the investigation noted that the area has poor visibility due to dust from ongoing road construction and low-lighting conditions on the roadway.

As per protocol, the officer involved in the crash was transported to Willis Knighton for routine procedural testing.

The SPD extends its deepest condolences to the family and friends of the deceased. We are committed to conducting a thorough and transparent investigation into this tragic incident.
