Shreveport Police Arrest Convicted Felon for Murder

The Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit has made an arrest in the July 17 homicide that claimed the life of a man in the 4700 block of Kennedy Drive. At approximately 6:50 p.m., officers responded to this location regarding a male deceased from a gunshot wound to the head.

Detectives from the Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Unit conducted an extensive investigation, which led to the issuance of a warrant for Everett Henderson, 23 years of age. At approximately 4:30 a.m., Shreveport Police Special Response Team members took Henderson into custody at a residence in the Pines Road area.

Henderson has been charged with one count of second-degree murder and one count of possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. Further arrests may be forthcoming.

Chief Wayne Smith commends the outstanding work of the detectives and SRT members involved in the investigation and apprehension of this violent criminal.
