The Shreveport Police Department's Sex Crimes Unit has issued an arrest warrant for Marco Howard, born August 23, 1985. Howard is wanted for one count of First-Degree Rape, a grave offense that carries severe legal consequences.

The warrant stems from a thorough investigation conducted by Shreveport police sex crimes detectives. While specific details of the case are confidential to protect the victim's privacy, it is crucial to note the serious nature of the allegations.
