Two Men Arrested During Traffic Stop

On August 12, 2024, at approximately 8:48 PM, Shreveport Police officers conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Topeka Street and Gilbert Drive. The vehicle was occupied by Grady Lewis, 53, and Ronnie Young, 56.

During the roadside investigation, officers determined that Ronnie Young was in possession of a Schedule II narcotic. When officers attempted to take Young into custody, he resisted with force. Despite this resistance, officers were able to subdue and arrest him. Young has been charged with possession of a Schedule II narcotic, possession of drug paraphernalia, resisting an officer with force and violence, as well as multiple traffic offenses.

The other occupant, Grady Lewis, was found to have multiple outstanding warrants, including one for theft and seven related to traffic violations. Both men were arrested, and Young received treatment for minor injuries sustained during the incident.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to proactive traffic enforcement and criminal interdiction, ensuring the safety and security of our community.
